- Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degree, or equivalent
- LWTech defines “equivalent” as 90 or more college level credits that minimally include 5 credits each of college level written communication, Math, and Social Science
- Minimum 2.0 GPA cumulative across all college coursework.

Required Courses for Application

The listed requirements must be met before filling out the admission application for the BAS in Behavioral Healthcare program

- Completion of at least 30 credits of College-level General Education prerequisite courses with a minimum of a 2.0 GPA in each class as follows:
 - [ENGL& 101 English Composition](#) or equivalent – 5 credits
 - Any English class above ENGL&101 or any Communications (CMST) course - 5 credits
 - [MATH& 107 Math in Society](#) (or any college-level, transferable [Quantitative Reasoning](#) course) - 5 credits
 - [Any Social Sciences](#) - 10 credits
 - [Any Humanities](#) - 5 credits
