Application Requirements

- Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degree, or equivalent, in a [social service- or health-related field](#).
- Students that earned degrees that are not on the approved list may be admitted conditionally. Additional information will be emailed to you from Selective Admission department.
- Minimum 2.5 GPA cumulative across all college coursework.
- \$50 Application Fee

Required Courses for Application

The listed requirements must be met before filling out the admission application for the BAS in Behavioral Healthcare program

- Completion of at least 30 credits of College-level General Education courses with a minimum 2.0 GPA in each of the following classes:
 - Communication Skills: 10 credits
 - Including ENGL& 101
 - Quantitative Reasoning: 5 credits
 - MATH&107 or any college level math course with Intermediate Algebra as a prerequisite
 - Social Sciences: 10 credits
 - Humanities: 5 credits
