Application Requirements

This degree has an academic bridge component that may be completed after admission but prior to entering the first quarter of program coursework. This allows students to complete general education coursework that may not have been taken in the course of completing the Associate level degree in their discipline. We encourage all applicants to work with an advisor in planning their path to applying to the BASPH. LWTech offers coursework in the summer to facilitate student completion of the academic bridge courses.

1. **Applicants must have earned an Applied Associate Degree, Direct Transfer Associate Degree, or equivalent from a regionally accredited institution to be eligible to apply.**
 - Degree equivalency is defined as completion of at least 90 college level quarter credits at a regionally accredited institution (or international equivalent)
 - If you have not completed your Applied Associate Degree, Direct Transfer Associate Degree, or equivalent you may still be considered for admission if you plan to do so prior to your planned first classes in the BASPH program.
2. **Completion of 30 credits of General Education from the list below with a minimum of a 2.0 GPA in each class.**
 - **Communication Skills - 10 credits:** Must include ENGL&101 or equivalent and one Speech or additional English writing course at the 100 or 200 level
 - Any **Social Sciences - 10 credits:** college level course
 - An **Introduction to Statistics - 5 credits:** MATH&146 or equivalent course with Intermediate Algebra as its prerequisite
 - **Natural Sciences - 5 credits:** Must include one course (5 credits) with lab

Students must have a 30 credits of the above courses completed at the time of admission. Students who have courses to complete at the time of admission may be admitted conditionally. Students with conditional admission must develop a plan (with the assistance of the Student Success Navigator) to complete the remaining courses.
3. **Minimum Cumulative 2.5 GPA across all college coursework in the associate degree.**
4. **Payment of \$50 non-refundable application fee.**
5. **Two recommendation forms attesting to the student's ability to succeed at the baccalaureate level.**
One from a college/university instructor and one from an employer (such as a supervisor). Students without previous work history may use two college instructors or your college advisor.
6. **Response to essay question**
Essays should exhibit effective communication skills consistent with work in Public Health. Essay question responses are evaluated on content, clarity of message, grammar and spelling. Upload your essay document

under the 'Essay' tab in this application.

Essay Question:

In the BASPH program, students will have the opportunity to work in groups on projects similar to what they would experience in a work environment in the field. Please write a brief statement addressing both the benefits you have experienced, and the challenges you have faced working/collaborating with groups that are both culturally and professionally diverse in membership.

Your essay question responses must:

- Be typed
- Address all parts of each question
- Be double-spaced

You have a minimum of one page and a, maximum of two pages.

Please note: Any evidence of plagiarism or academic dishonesty in your application materials will render your application unacceptable and all materials will be forwarded to the conduct officer for review and possible adjudication.

**If applications exceed available space, selection will be based on:

1. Date application was received, and
2. Cumulative GPA from Associate Degree.

Once your application is completed, make sure to click the "Submit Application" button on the last page. If you do not "Submit" you application is considered incomplete and will not be reviewed.
